- 4. Employment Experience Candidates should have held a job and saved some money for their education.
- 5. Community Involvement Candidates should demonstrate volunteer experience, and participation in extra-curricular activities.
- 6. Residency Students must be residents of Cape Ann.

Sylvester "Red" Deering Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Preference will be given to children of Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce members and their employees (but only if they meet all other criteria).
- 2. GHS students and Essex Tech, Rockport, and Manchester/Essex students who are **residents of Cape Ann** and continuing their education in the Trades are eligible.
- 3. Applicants must be pursuing the field of business or trades.
- 4. Academic record Applicants must be in the top 50% of their class.
- 5. Financial Need Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- 6. Employment Experience Candidates should have held a job and saved some money for their education.
- 7. Community Involvement Candidates should show volunteer experience, and participation in extra-curricular activities.
