Five scholarships will be awarded by the Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce, as follows:

Michael Costello Scholarship.....one (1) at \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, as well as Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, are eligible.

Sylvester "Red" Deering Scholarship.....one (1) at \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, as well as Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in the Trades, are eligible.

Rudolph "Rudy" Macchi Scholarship.....one (1) at \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, as well as Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, are eligible.

Pat Roy Scholarship..... one (1) at \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, as well as Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in Business at the collegiate level, are eligible.

Mr. & Mrs. L. Dexter Woodman Scholarship..... one (1) at \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, as well as Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, are eligible.

Guidelines for Michael Costello, Rudolph "Rudy" Macchi and Mr. & Mrs. L. Dexter Woodman Scholarships:

1. Preference will be given to children of Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce members and their employees (but only if they meet all other criteria).
2. Scholarship - Candidates should have proven academic performance.
3. Career Plans - Candidates should be planning to pursue studies in Business or a related field.
4. Employment Experience - Candidates should have held a job and saved some money for their education.
5. Community Involvement - Candidates should demonstrate volunteer experience, and participation in extra-curricular activities.

2. GHS students and Essex Tech, Rockport, and Manchester/Essex students who are residents of Cape Ann and continuing their education in the Trades are eligible.
