Six scholarships will be awarded by the Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce, as follows:

Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce Scholarship.....minimum \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, and Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in Business or a related field at the collegiate level are eligible.

Michael Costello Scholarship.....minimum \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, and Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in Business or a related field at the collegiate level are eligible.

Sylvester "Red" Deering Scholarship.....minimum \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, as well as Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in the Trades are eligible.

Rudolph "Rudy" Macchi Scholarship.....minimum \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, and Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in Business or a related field at the collegiate level are eligible.

Pat Roy Scholarship.....minimum \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, and Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in Business or a related field at the collegiate level are eligible.

Mr. & Mrs. L. Dexter Woodman Scholarship.....minimum \$1,000

- GHS, RHS and MERHS students, and Essex Tech students who are Cape Ann residents, continuing their education in Business or a related field at the collegiate level are eligible.

Guidelines for Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce, Michael Costello, Rudolph "Rudy" Macchi, Pat Roy and Mr. & Mrs. L. Dexter Woodman Scholarships:

1. Career Plans - Candidates should be planning to pursue studies in Business or a related field.
2. Savings/ Employment Experience - Candidates should have held a job and saved some money for their education.
3. Community Involvement - Candidates should demonstrate volunteer experience, and participation in extra-curricular activities.
4. Preference will be given to children of Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce members and their employees (but only if they meet all other criteria).

1. Career Plans - GHS students and Essex Tech, Rockport, and Manchester/Essex students who are residents of Cape Ann and continuing their education in the Trades.

4. Preference will be given to children of Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce members and their employees (but only if they meet all other criteria).
